

# RECYCLING GUIDELINES FOR 580 EYER DRIVE

*There are five recycling stations located throughout the parking garage. Place your recycling in the appropriate bins. Do not place other items in or around the bins. DO **NOT** PLACE PLASTIC BAGS IN ANY RECYCLING BINS.*

## IN THE "CONTAINERS" BIN

- Aluminum pie plates, trays and foil
- Clear cold drink cups and lids
- Clear egg cartons
- Clear molded bakery item trays
- Clear plastic fruit and vegetable containers
- Empty aerosol cans (lid removed)
- Glass bottles and jars (place metal lid in bag separately)
- Metal food and beverage cans
- Milk, juice and soup cartons and drinking boxes
- Plastic bottles with a twist-off cap (cap left on) up to 15 litres in size
- Plastic takeout food containers
- Plastic tubs and lids e.g. yogurt, ice cream, margarine (up to four litres in size)

## IN THE "PAPER" BIN

- Cardboard boxes or cartons - flattened
- Cards and envelopes
- Catalogues, telephone books and calendars
- Clean pizza boxes
- Dry foods boxes (liners removed)
- Gift wrap (No foil. Please reuse.)
- Junk mail, flyers and writing paper
- Newspaper Magazines and soft-cover books
- Office, computer and scrap paper
- Shoe, gift or packaging boxes – broken down
- Tissue boxes
- Toilet paper and paper towel rolls

## IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE

(placed in green garbage bags, max 5k)

- Cookie or snack bags and inserts/trays
- Egg cartons off all types
- Film such as Saran wrap
- Foam cups, plates, trays (including take out and meat trays)
- Foil gift wrap
- Metal or plastic hangers
- Nursery/plant pots
- Paper serviettes, napkins or towels
- Plastic Bags including: shopping, milk, produce, freezer or sandwich
- Take-out coffee drinking cups and lids or straws
- Take-out trays

## ITEMS REQUIRING SPECIAL HANDLING

- Aerosols with fluids (DRWM)
- Antifreeze (DRWM)
- Automobile batteries, brake fluids, oil filters or waste oil (DRWM)
- Ceramics, drinking glasses (VV)
- Electronics including TVs, vcrs, computer peripherals, cd players, telephones
- Extinguishers, thermostats, pesticides, , pool and spa chemicals, poisons and propane or helium cylinders or tanks. (DRWM)
- Garden waste – place next to blue bins at north garage ramp
- Light bulbs, compact fluorescent light bulbs and tubes \* (BPU)
- Paints, varnishes and solvents (DRWM)
- Pharmaceuticals –take unused/outdated prescription or OTC medicines to your druggist
- Pots, pans or baking trays (VV)
- Propane or helium tanks (BPU or DRWM)
- Styrofoam packaging (DRWM)
- Tires (DRWM)
- Window glass or mirrors \* (BPU)
- Wine bottles and boxes, beer and spirits containers – return to Beer Store

\*please wrap/tape securely to prevent breakage)

BPU – Scheduled bulk pick up (usually 2x per year)

DRWM - Durham Region's Waste Management Facilities, 1640 Ritson Road North

VV – Donate to Value Village - 609 Kingston Rd or Salvation Army - 1360 Kingston Rd
